
DAY 2 Balloon Fiesta's "Mass Ascension" and Evening "Balloon Glow": Depart very early for Fiesta Park, Founded

in 1972, the Fiesta began with 13 balloons and has grown to more than 600 balloons from all over the world. View the "mass ascension" of these specially shaped balloons as they lift off at sunrise. Get ready for a real treat this evening at the Balloon Glow event. Just before dusk, the burners of nearly 500 balloons are ignited and the evening sky fills with a kaleidoscope of brilliant, luminous color. DAY 3 Albuquerque City Tour and Indian Pueblo Cultural Center: Today, enjoy a city tour and explore the history of
